

When I moved from Chile to Barcelona, I took with me the box of family records my grandmother gave me to stay connected to my roots. While discussing these images with my relatives, a cousin revealed our family's best-kept secret: our maternal grandmother, María Elena, was adopted and her biological family was Mapuche. Intrigued, I obsessively delved into these records, uncovering voids and unsettling silences in our history. Inspired by the supercomputer that produces knowledge for society in this city, I decided to use machine artificial intelligence to reconstruct the missing pieces and make sense of my true origin in a cinematic essay spanning 70 years of Chilean history.


